Where the Cranes Return

Where the Cranes Return is edited through distance rather than a behavioral narrative. A bird descends into open ground, cranes move across snow, a single body meets its reflection, two birds occupy the same field, one lowers its beak to water, and the sequence closes at close range.

The edit stays with posture, spacing, movement and scale without assigning kinship or intention.
